2. Outreach Report—Unit Director, Ben Watson

Director Watson talked about our involvement with the Nebraska State Fair. The NEOC had a booth at the Fair from August 25- September 4th, where it was estimated that around 1600 people visited the booth. Staff was able to hand out jar grippers and share information about the agency. Director Watson recognized the staff that helped staff the booth as it was a coordinated effort to ensure coverage.

Director Watson discussed HUD's Fair Housing Leadership Conference in Denver that he and Director Gardner attended. The conference had a lot of great information including discriminatory home appraisals, and use of AI, especially with advertising.

3. Director's Report - Executive Director, Paula Gardner

Director Gardner introduced Brett Ekstrum as the newest investigator and Megan McCaul as Lincoln's Office Specialist to the commissioners.

Director Gardner announced that on October 4, 2023 the NEOC will be holding an all staff meeting in Omaha, at the Chalco Hills NRD Office. The agenda will cover Pregnant Workers Fairness Act, recent Supreme Court ruling, and Agency updates. The Commissioners were invited to stop by anytime from about 9:30 am - 3:00 pm.

Director Gardner stated that the NEOC is preparing to post Kathy Bogenreif's position. She explained that the plan is to hire someone in November, so Kathy can help train for her position before she retires.

Director Gardner notified the commissioners of Nebraska's recent Executive Order. After some examination, she reported that current practices comply with the Order.

Director Gardner asked Commissioners about the mailing of their commission packets after realizing they arrived much later than anticipated. She reminded them of the access they have to the case files on the Sharepoint website and how to access cases from there. There was discussion about other options to view the information online, including possibly using secured Share File or a portal with the new website still be built.
