1. Previous Month's General Ledger Report

2. Outreach Report—Unit Director, Ben Watson

Director Watson stated there is a scheduled outreach webinar presentation with US Department of Labor for the Indian Community College. He will be presenting on employment discrimination for the students, faculty, and staff.

Director Watson announced we're close to having NEOC's website finished within the next couple of months. Once it is functional, it will be reviewed with Commissioners and staff. Hurdles were discussed regarding a host for the website that have been resolved.

Director Watson mentioned HUD grant money to translate NEOC documents materials in Spanish.

Director Watson stated there has been very positive feedback on the NEOC's commercial currently airing.

3. Director's Report - Executive Director, Paula Gardner

Director Gardner introduced Donnita Brown, the new Admin Tech in Omaha. She will be doing the minutes for the Omaha commission meetings.

Director Gardner explained about a meeting coming up to discuss the final steps to move forward with the website. A much clearer picture of when the website will completed will be available after this meeting.

Director Gardner announced two new investigator positions are open in Lincoln. We are currently advertising for the openings, with the plan to interview on March 4th, and a target start date of April 1st.

Director Gardner indicated work continues on the database.

Director Gardner stated the public hearing has been rescheduled. March 27th and 28th. Commissioners were invited to attend the hearing, in order to share with the other Commissioners what happened at the hearing to report back to the other Commissioners as they are responsible for voting on the final order.

Director Gardner asked how the commissioners would like their mileage expense reports sent to them, paper or electronically. It was decided to provide the reports via e-mail.

4. Legislative Update--

Director Gardner stated she testified in a neutral capacity on LB977 that adds military and veteran's status to our laws as a protected class. No one testified in opposition.

Director Gardner reported that she reached out to the senator on LB1240. Unfortunately, no one got back to her in time before she had to submit a statement. She opted to submit a statement in opposition based on the motion in last month's meeting. Neither of the bills have been made priority bills by the senators who introduced them, so she doesn't anticipate any formal action being taken on them.

Director Gardner said she was approached for LB1012, which wants to remove post-secondary education requirements for state employment, absent a necessity. She was notified that the NEOC would be put in charge of compliance/enforcement. She responded that she did not feel that this was necessary as the agency responsible indicated they are able to handle the requirements of the bill and there is already a mechanism for the public to make a complaint through the ombudsman's office. There was also concern about the timeline for completing these investigations as it did not match our current investigative process.
