Proclamation

WHEREAS,

The Nebraska Fair Housing Act and the equivalent federal law, Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, protect the essential need of every person to have affordable, adequate, and safe shelter without the barrier of discrimination based on race, religion, color, sex, disability, national origin, or familial status; and

WHEREAS,

The people of Nebraska must continue, through the efforts of dedicated public workers and persons in the housing industry, to abide by and enforce the laws that provide each person residing in Nebraska a place to live without compromise of safety, dignity, or fairness; and

WHEREAS,

The State of Nebraska recognizes the dedicated efforts of the individuals and resources of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, the State of Nebraska Equal Opportunity Commission, the City of Omaha Human Rights and Relations Department, the City of Lincoln Commission on Human Rights, The Nebraska REALTORS Association, the Family Housing Advisory Services/Fair Housing Center of Nebraska, the Nebraska Department of Economic Development, and many other groups and individuals working collectively to eliminate housing discrimination in Nebraska.

NOW, THEREFORE,

I, Jim Pillen, Governor of the State of Nebraska, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM the Month of April 2025 as



FAIR HOUSING MONTH

in Nebraska, and I do hereby urge all citizens to take due note of this observance.
